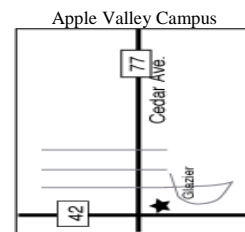
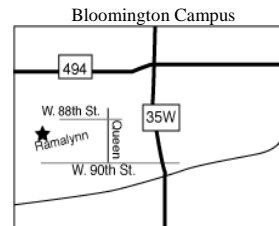
Drama Club & Theater- Midsummer Night's Dream

Math Mastery- Grades 1-4

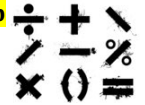
Students who struggle with math will get help reinforcing the basic skills and concepts they need to understand to progress to the next grade level.
